# Agreements

- Students are expected to participate in all Health and Medial Professional events. Attendance is vital to each student’s success in the program. No unexcused absences or excessive absences as defined by the LCSD are permitted (School Board Policy 4.16)
- Students will be accountable for their behavior at all times. Greater than three (3) referrals or one (1) suspension during the sophomore and junior years may prevent a student from advancing to the next level course(s). Greater than one (1) referral or suspension during the senior year may result in removal from the clinical site.
- An overall GPA of 2.0 is required to apply to the academy and a 2.5 GPA must be maintained in HS I and HS II for progression. Rising Juniors must maintain a minimum of a 2.5 GPA to enter HS1.

**All students are subject to administrator review on discipline, attendance and GPA at any point during the calendar year with penalties ranging from warnings to dismissal from the Academy.**

Space in the Nursing Assisting and Allied Health Assisting courses taken senior year is limited to the top sixty students in the Academy. Acceptance into the courses may be dependent on administrative review of discipline and attendance records. Upon acceptance into the Nursing Assisting and Allied Health Assisting courses, all students must complete the following requirements. All students must:

- Be able to perform the “Essential Functions and Physical Requirements for a Nursing Assistant”.
- Have transportation provided by themselves to and from the clinical assignments. Carpooling with other students is not permitted.
- Satisfactorily complete the Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers CPR course.
- Obtain a negative test for Tuberculosis. This test will be offered during class by an Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner. The results must be read within 48 to 72 hours of the administration of the test. Failure to be in attendance for the administration or reading of this test will require that the student obtain this test at his/her own cost of approximately \$20.00. Cost of this test when offered at the high school is complimentary from Lee Health.
- Receive an influenza vaccine (flu shot) and have all vaccinations up to date. Students must submit a copy of their vaccination record. This is required and there are no exceptions.
- Obtain a negative screening for drugs through a Lab Corp facility. The cost of this screening will be paid for by the School District of Lee County. If a drug screen is positive, the student will not be eligible to engage in clinical activities. **If the drug screen is not completed within 48 hours of receiving paperwork, the student may not be eligible to engage in clinical activities**
- Undergo a background review by the School Resource Officer. Certain arrests will prevent the student from being able to be assigned to a clinical facility. Fingerprinting for Level 2 background screening may be required by some clinical affiliates. If these facilities are used for clinical experiences, then the Level 2 screening will be required for all students.
- Pass a written pretest with a score of 85% or higher in order to be eligible to take the Nursing Assisting Certification exam given by the state or any other state or national exam that will lead to Industry Certification.
- Undergo fingerprinting and level 2 background screening to be eligible to take the Nursing Assisting Certification exam. Students are responsible for the cost of fingerprinting.
- Complete a minimum of forty clinical hours, twenty of which must be completed in a long-term care facility.
