



## Estero High School Athletic Paperwork Checklist

---

- Have a 2.0 unweighted (state) GPA or higher
- Completed the athletic clearance FHSAA part 1-4 consent from liability certificate, emergency contact information and other information in the athletic clearance website: <https://athleticclearance.fhsaahome.org/>
- Turned in a hard copy of notarized page to the athletic office or uploaded it to the athletic clearance website.
- Turned in a hard copy of the physical to the athletic office or uploaded it to the athletic clearance website (physical evaluations are valid for 365 calendar days from the day the exam took place).
- Turned in copy of your birth certificate to the athletic office (one time only)
- Have personal or school insurance

- \* Transferred to Estero High after attending another high school? Please contact the Athletic Office immediately.

### Other Important information

If you wish to be a part of WILDCAT ATHLETICS, you must fulfill the following obligations:

1. Paperwork must be completed in full and signed by a parent/guardian in the presence of a notary. There is a notary available at Estero High School for your convenience from 7am-2:30pm during the regular school year. There is no charge for this service. **IT IS ILLEGAL FOR A FLORIDA NOTARY TO NOTARIZE A PAPER THAT IS NOT COMPLETELY FILLED OUT.**
2. In order to abide by the Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSAA) which regulates interscholastic sports in Florida, **every** student must turn in a birth certificate before competing in interscholastic sports for the first time at Estero High School.
3. Every athlete **must** have accident insurance. If you do not have insurance, please come to the Athletic Office to obtain a School Insurance application. This information can also be found at [www.schoolinsuranceofflorida.com](http://www.schoolinsuranceofflorida.com)
4. If you are a first time athlete to EHS coming from a private school or out-of-state, you need verification of grades, i.e. report cards or transcripts.

The athletic office is here to assist you in becoming a Wildcat Athlete; however, we cannot do your work. Make sure that all of your paperwork is completely and properly filled out. **If it is not, it will be returned to you!!** Athletes are not permitted to participate, even practice or condition (including summer workouts), unless all paperwork (including physical exam) is turned in.
